The 230 San Ildefonso route provides service Monday through Friday and is fare-free.

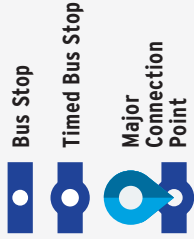

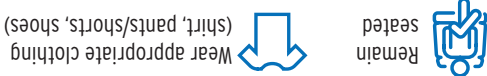

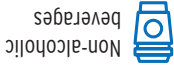
Remain seated
